SPOOKY SEASON

What is Halloween? Halloween is a holiday celebrated on October 31st. It is a time for activities such as trick-or-treating, carving jack-o-lanterns, festive gatherings, costumes, and treats/candy. However, this is not how the spooky season has always been celebrated.

The holiday originates back to the ancient Celtic festival of Samhain. The Celts lived 2,000 years ago in the area now known as Ireland, the United Kingdom, and northern France. The Celts celebrated their new year on November 1st, which marked the end of summer, and the beginning of winter. They believed that on the night before the new year, the boundary between the worlds of the living and the dead became blurred. Traditionally, on the night of October 31st they celebrated Samhain, when it was believed that the ghosts of the dead returned to earth. People would light bonfires and wear costumes to ward off ghosts.

Today, in the United States, on Halloween children dress up in costume to go trick-or-treating, going from house to house to collect treats and candies. People will celebrate Halloween by having parties, playing games, going on hayrides, or haunted houses. Some even carve pumpkins to turn them into jack o'lanterns, then set them outside their house for all to see.
