<u>Ingredients</u>

- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 2 large eggs
- 1 can (15 ounce) Libby's* Pure Pumpkin
- 1 can (12 fluid ounces)
 Nestle* Carnation*
 Evaporated Milk (Or
 substitute with equal
 amount Lactose-Free or
 Almond Cooking Milk)
- 1 unbacked 9-inch deep dish pie shell

Instructions

- 1. Mix sugar, cinnamon, ginger and cloves in a small bowl. Beat eggs in large bowl. Stir in pumpkin and sugar-spice mixture. Gradually stir in evaporated milk
- 2. Pour into pie shell.
- 3. Bake in preheated 425° F oven for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 350° F; bake for 40 minutes or until knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack for 2 hours. Serve immediately or refidgerate.
