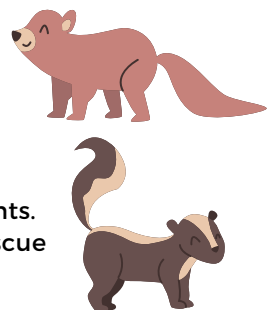

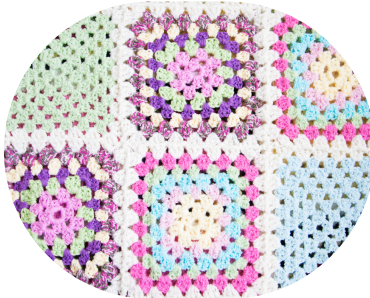

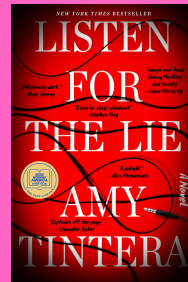
Greene Library Community Cookbook

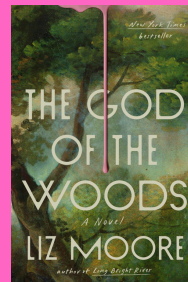
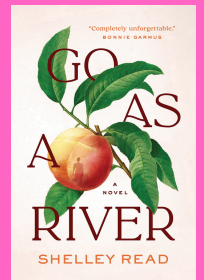


Mystery Book Club April 2, 12pm

April's book club pick is Go as a River by Shelley Read, a coming-of-age story set in 1940s Colorado.

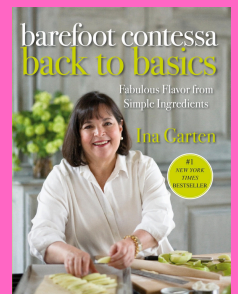


Fireside Book Club April 24, 6pm
