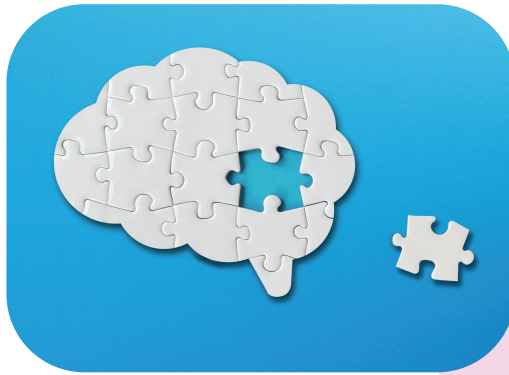

Yarn Donations

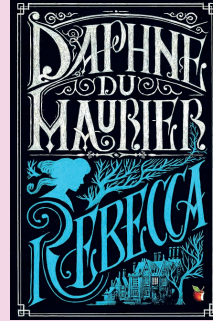

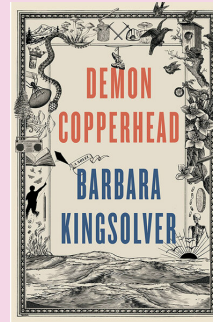
